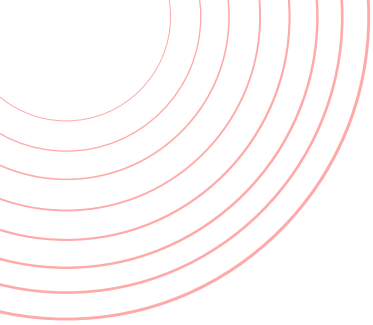

We thank you parents that we get to partner with you to raise up the next generation. This year we will dance with purpose & perform with power while also giving each student a chance to grow in their confidence, dance and leadership skills.

We welcome you to our dance family! We are delighted you want to dance, tumble, learn, grow, and create with us!

Dance Arts is committed to building character and enhancing lives through our programs, performances and classes.

We value the process & progression and we believe firmly in ballet being the foundation for all dance. We strongly suggest each dancer start in ballet

and then add tumbling at age 5, tap at age 6, jazz at age 7, and hip hop and contemporary at age 8.

Our main goal is to help the dancers learn more about their specific form of dance. But in addition,

- we want them to realize the art, culture, and heritage of their chosen form
- to achieve a disciplined attitude
- to have more self awareness
- to know self-discipline, physical development, & achievement go hand in hand
- to find & obtain the joy for music & movement

We look forward to a new year of classes, new friends, new skills learned, as well as our Mini Recitals June 7-10th, 2027, a spring Studio Dance Theatre production, Dance Arts Performing CORE and Imagine Worship events. We are blessed to have Miss Hazel's Music Studio offering guitar, piano, and voice lessons all year to help make our students well rounded individuals.
